GRAND CHAPTER ORDER OF THE EASTERN STAR OF ALABAMA

SUSAN CURRY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

PURRPOSE: The Susan Curry Memorial Scholarship Program was formed to provide financial assistance to university, college, or technical school students. The Order of the Eastern Star of Alabama Susan Curry Memorial Scholarship Program is for all eligible students now attending or moving into post-secondary education, technical or occupational training.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS: (1) The applicant must be a United States citizen and (2) a resident of the State of Alabama (except for the purpose of attending school), (3) provide proof of acceptance or attendance in an accredited postgraduate or technical school and (4) demonstrate and maintain a minimum of a 2.5 GPA or better (on a scale of 4.0).

AWARD DETAILS: This scholarship is awarded for one academic year only, but eligible recipients may reapply for consideration in future academic years by meeting the established reapplication criteria. The student applicant must attend an accredited institution and understand that scholarship funds will be paid directly to the Institution on behalf of the student. The academic scholarship is for \$5,000 and the vocational/technical scholarship is for \$3,000.

SELECTION & AWARD PROCESS: Selections will normally be made by April 15th each year or as soon as practical thereafter. Decisions are at the sole discretion of the OES of Alabama Scholarship Committee and are considered final. All information will remain strictly confidential. All information submitted and discussed by the committee shall remain confidential. To the extent possible, a representative of the Eastern Star will present scholarship awards to recipients in an appropriate ceremony at the recipient's school.

APPLICANT RESPONSIBILITIES: The applicant is responsible for ensuring that the submission package is complete and submitted in time to arrive at the Grand Chapter by the close of business March 1 of the appropriate year. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered. Faxed copies and packages left outside the Grand Chapter door will not be accepted.

SUBMISSION: The applicant is responsible for ensuring that all requirements are met. Incomplete or late applications **will not** be considered. It is imperative that you review the program guidelines prior to completing this form.
